When fabricating and specifying hose assemblies ask the following questions:

Size: What is the I.D. (inside diameter) of the hose?

What is the O.D (outside diameter) of the hose?

Temperature: What is the temperature range of the media (product) that is flowing through the hose assembly?

Application: How is the hose assembly actually being used?

Is it a pressure application? Is it a vacuum (suction) application?

Material: What media/material that is flowing through the hose assembly?

Pressure: What is the maximum pressure including surges that this hose assembly will be subjected to?

Ends: What couplings have been requested?

Delivery: When is the hose required by?
